

#### Early Voting Against Issue 1 – Puts Women at Risk

The Catholic Church honors Mary, the Mother of God, as the perfect model of the love that God wants to share with every person. woman has guaranteed access to a hospital during an abortion in case of an

Our faith teaches us that pregnant women deserve a community of support, so Catholics cannot be silent when an extreme amendment threatens to remove protections for women's health and safety. If you do not meet your full fund-raising obligation, you will be billed the balance due. This must be paid before the last day of school.
